Come Join Us

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a twist in farming that reconnects families *back* to a local farmer that grows their food. Members receive farm fresh veggies throughout the growing season and enjoy reconnecting back to the land and growing seasons with a direct link to their farm.

McDougal's Farm is now accepting membership applications for the **2021 growing season**. It's simple: you pay for a season's worth of vegetables before the growing season begins and we deliver them to the designated drop off site of your choice for 17 or 9 weeks, beginning early June to mid October. Early sign up is recommended and helps us with our planning.

What You Receive as a CSA Member

- Approximately **17 weeks** (or 9 if you choose the Every other week Box) of **chemical free vegetables** grown in an **Earth friendly** manner, delivered as early as the second week in June through mid October depending on frost.
- **Seasonally fresh herbs** as available
- **Weekly farm newsletters** with useful recipes and healthy living tips
- Invitations and updates on **family farm events, children's and adult workshops**.
- The opportunity to order additional **canning vegetables**
- **Peace of mind** in knowing that you are feeding your family **nutritious, safely handled food** reserved weekly just for you....no need to beat the market.
- **A farm** with which you and your family are welcome to be involved in the planting and harvesting as much or as little as you wish.
- The **opportunity** to share with your children home cooking & the growing process which we hope will be a part of their future.

June Sample box:

1 lb. bag of lettuce mix, 3/4 lb. snap peas, 1 bunch of radishes, green onions or leek, 1 bunch of beets, 1 lb. of sauté greens or spinach, 1 bunch of rhubarb, 1 kohlrabi, parsley. deleted bunch of carrots

August Sample box:

2 heads of Romaine lettuce, 4 tomatoes (heirlooms and slicers), 1 pt. cherry tomatoes, 3 onions, 2 bell peppers, 1 lb. green or yellow beans, 2-3 small zucchinis or summer squash, 3 cucumbers, 1 head of broccoli, and 1 bunch of basil.

October Sample box:

1 lb. lettuce mix, 1 head of cauliflower, 1 head of broccoli, 2 heads of garlic, 1 bunch of carrots, 3 lb.

of potatoes, 1 butternut or acorn squash, 1 bunch of celery, 3 red onions, and 1 bunch of kale.

Where We are Located

Our farm is located at W10835 Bluebell Rd. in Deerbrook, WI (about 8 minutes from Antigo's north side)

Drop off / Pick up Sites

You will be informed of set weekly **Thursday** pick up time at the following drop sites by May 31st. You may choose from one of the following: the **Farm** (Deerbrook), **Green Hen Natural Living** (Antigo), **Sweet Thyme** (Antigo's Northside) **Bass Lake** (Summit Lake area), **New Rhinelander site** (Rhinelander), **Red Clover Market**, Weston (Wausau area), **Wellness Center** (Merrill) or **Lotter's BP** (Pickerel)

How it Works

1. Pick up your box at an agreed upon location on the same day as delivery. This is important for freshness and as a courtesy to your host. Send a friend if you can't make it.
2. Stay connected, read your families weekly emailed newsletter and provide us with feedback. This is one of the perks of a CSA....**you get to know your farmer!**



Share Options

Every other week- (\$27.30/week)

Two payments of \$124.35 or 1 payment of \$245.70 by June 1st. This is an **every other week box** (9 out of the 17 week season), for singles, smaller appetites or families on the go that still want to eat healthy.

Standard Share- (\$23.29/week) Most Popular! Two payments of \$199.50 or 1 payment of \$396. by June 1st. A weekly ½ bushel box of fresh veggies for 17 weeks. This share is best for 2 people or a family that may not use many vegetables.

Large Share- (\$31.70/week) Best Value! 2 payments of \$271. or 1 payment of \$539. by June 1st. The large share is a weekly 3/4 bushel box of fresh veggies. Has the same variety as the standard but includes about 30% more veggies. A good 4-5 person or large family size.

Worker Share: We offer a limited number of worker shares for people interested in working on the farm for their weekly share . Please call for more information. **715-627-4418**

Helping Hand Fund- (Donation)

A contribution of your choice to the Helping Hand Fund allows you to partially pay another family's (with limited income) membership into the CSA. **If you contribute to the Helping Hand Fund, you will be considered a farm member and welcome at all farm events.**

Workshops: We have several early Spring family workshops held in our big sunny greenhouse. Some are tailored to children, like making toad houses or planting marigolds, while others, like Organic Gardening 101 or Cooking With Herbs are geared for adults, others include the whole family.

Farm Events: In the past we have had events such as Earth Day/Earth Blessing, Open House, Movie Night and our favorite, Bonfire Night. Each year we also host educational guest speakers.

Shout Out Days: "Shout Outs" are your chance to experience your farm in action. your chance to get dirty. These are not mandatory but strongly encouraged for you to reconnect to your farmer and the place where your food is grown.
